

SPRING ARM DOOR CLOSER

FIXING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Decide where the closer is to be fixed - on a flush door this may be anywhere - on a panel door it must be on one of the horizontal rails and not over a panel
- 2) Ensure that the part of the door jamb where the closer is to be fitted is flat
- 3) To fix the body to the door jamb place in the required position:-

IMPORTANT

THE DOOR CLOSER MUST BE FITTED THE CORRECT WAY FOR DIFFERENTLY HANDED DOORS - IF UNCORRECTLY FITTED IT WILL BECOME DAMAGED

VIEWED FROM ABOVE THE ARROW ON THE END CAP MUST POINT IN THE DIRECTION OF THE DOOR.

Screw in the fixing screws ensuring that the body is square to the door

- 4) Turn the centre boss away from the door with any suitable tool (ie .Phillips Screwdriver) screw the arm into the hole nearest the door. If more tension is required repeat the operation. If less tension is required release back one hole at a time. Do not pretension by more than one full turn.
- 5) Tack or glue the roller plate into position under the rollers to protect the face of the door.
- 6) Insert the 4 screw hole blanking plugs. These are a push fit.
